Ninoslav Babić has joined the Croatian Customs Directorate in March 2007. After a year and a half of internship at Jankomir Customs Office, the largest inland customs office in Croatia, he was positioned at the Central Office of the Customs Directorate in September 2008, where he exclusively deals with IPR enforcement matters. His main duties are managing Applications for Action and COPIS and assisting local officers in customs IPR infringement cases but he is also engaged in interagency and international cooperation, delivering and carrying out educational programmes for front-line customs officers and communication with media and consumers in IPR enforcement matters.

At national level, he is a member of several bodies within national coordination of interagency cooperation in IPR enforcement (Coordination Committee, Legislation WG, Right-Holders Cooperation WG, Public Awareness WG and Statistics WG). At international level, he is a permanent representative of the Customs Directorate at the DG TAXUD Customs Code Committee – IPR Enforcement Section, a member of the IPR Enforcement Working Group at the EU IPO Observatory and a member of the EDB Steering Group.

Ninoslav Babić was two times a speaker at the national annual IPR conference Intelektiv, he represents Customs Directorate at all national IPR related events and held over 30 presentations at seminars and conferences nationally and internationally.
