Nicole Semjevski joined the Office for Harmonization in the Internal Market (Trade Marks and Designs), now EUIPO, in April 2000 to work in the Registry of the Boards of Appeal.

In May 2008 she was appointed to work in the newly created Lab - Quality Management Department Laboratory. With a planned lifespan of two years, the Lab consisted of a small team – representing business and IT - that developed prototypes for future OHIM IT tools.

After the Lab project ended, she continued to work for the Quality Management Department, being tasked, among other activities, with the internal preparation for the accession of Croatia to the EU.

Since September 2011, Nicole Semjevski has worked for the European Observatory on Infringements of Intellectual Property Rights, the first 9 months while still under the framework of the MoU signed with the European Commission. Since October 2013 she is part of the Enforcement Database (EDB) team.
